

Eagle Point School District Plan for Risk Level & School Re-entry

Student is identified as needing a risk assessment due to behavior, self-report, peer report or other concerns.
- Notify Admin, HS Counselor, or trained designee

Columbia Suicide Severity Rating Scale (CSSRS) is administered to student by trained staff

HIGH RISK
Yes to #1 & #2 and any combination of yes to #3, #4, #5, #6.

LOW RISK
No to all or yes to #1 but no to rest.

Moderate RISK
Yes to #1 & #2, but no to rest of questions or denial of any plan after answering question #1.

HIGH RISK
-Call home to inform parent.
-Create Safety Plan with student.
-Parents/Guardians must pick up student. Student must be supervised by school staff at all times.
-Provide parents the JCMH Crisis Center information; White City/Medford location available.
-Call JCMH (541) 774-8201 & ask for Crisis Line with parent & student present to refer youth to the Crisis Center.
-Ask JCMH Crisis Center staff to notify Jill Jeter/Youth Suicide Prevention Coordinator (541) 770-7776 jeterjn@jacksoncounty.org
- Document in Private Tab of Student's Health Folder.

Low Risk
-Call parents after screening.
-Student may go home on the bus, if so document phone number and any notes on safety plan.
-Document in Private Tab of Student's Health Folder.

Medium Risk
-Create Safety Plan with student.
-Call home after screening and safety plan are complete.
-Parents/Guardians must pick student up from school. Student must be supervised by school staff at all times.
-Provide parents the JCMH Crisis Center information; White City/Medford locations available.
-Notify JCMH (541) 774-8201 & ask for Crisis Center. Inform them that youth was referred to Crisis Center.
-Ask JCMH Crisis Center staff to notify Jill Jeter/Youth Suicide Prevention Coordinator (541) 770-7776 jeterjn@jacksoncounty.org
- Document in Private Tab of Student's Health Folder.

If student is not seen at JCMH within 24 hours, Law Enforcement/CPS Welfare Call should be placed by school staff.

- If Non-School Day – Contact Crisis Line and request they check in with student.

Student Returns to School

Low Risk Re-entry
-Student may return to school.
-Provide staff with a Care Alert.

Moderate Risk Re-entry
-Provide staff with a Care Alert.
-School administrator/counselor/psych checks in with student

High Risk Re-Entry
- Provide staff with a Care Alert.
-Check in with student required by counselor/psych
-Will create an individualized plan for the day or week.
-Hospital Notification should be treated as high risk.
